

Businesses that handle or store hazardous substances in quantity (<200 lbs) or have infiltration systems that manage storm water from parking lots or other industrial surfaces (by means of slot drain, drywell, detention pond, etc.) are required to obtain a South Tacoma Groundwater Protection District (STGPD) operating permit [Tacoma Municipal Code- Chapter 13.09]

Each facility that is required to obtain an STGPD operating permit must provide an inventory of all hazardous substances used or generated at the facility; demonstrate compliance with hazardous substance management practices [including Underground and Aboveground Storage Tank (UST/AST) standards where applicable], and supply records of infiltration systems use and maintenance when such systems are present.

The Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department will perform an initial inspection once the application/facility information sheet is received. Biennial inspection will be performed in subsequent years.
